Employees can lease their favourite bicycle and save tax in the process if their employer offers bicycle leasing.

Minor technical problems with bicycles can be easily fixed at the free repair stations (Radservicestationen) in the city of Aachen.

The self-service stations are equipped with air pumps and basic tools.

Bicycle parking

The city of Aachen offers various parking facilities for bicycles:

- **Bicycle stands**
- **Bicycle parking in car parks** (railway station & town hall)
- **Bike+Ride** (covered at bus stops)
- **Bicycle box** (Eilendorf railway station)
- **Radstation** (railway station: incl. repairs, bicycle rentals and sales)
- **Bike-Stations** (secure, weather-protected and enclosed parking facilities, bookable and accessible via radbox.nrw as of 2026, secure bicycle parking spaces can also be booked via radbox.nrw in various other cities)

Taking bicycles on the train

On trains with a multi-purpose compartment (with a bicycle symbol), bicycles can be carried around the clock with a bicycle ticket. Each person may only take one bicycle. The following rules apply on trains without a multi-purpose compartment:

- Two bicycles in the boarding areas (if sufficient space is available)
- Monday to Friday from 9 to 15:30 and from 18; Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays all day

Taking bicycles on the bus

Some restrictions apply to the carriage of bicycles on buses:

- One to two bicycles per bus
- One bicycle per person
- Monday to Friday from 19, Saturdays from 15; Sundays and public holidays all day
- Only with a bicycle ticket.

**Note: The transport of passengers, strollers and wheelchairs always has priority on buses and trains. Staff may decide on a case-by-case basis whether bicycles can be taken on board. Folding scooters and folding bicycles are considered hand baggage.*

Shared mobility

Bike sharing

If you don't have a bicycle yourself, you can rent an e-bike (pedelec). From early 2026, Aachen will once again be home to bike-sharing stations with over 400 pedelecs. The bicycles can be returned to any station in Aachen.

Borrow a cargo bike

In Aachen, you can borrow over 26 e-cargo bikes free of charge. Depending on the location, you can book them for up to 3 hours or a day. Register conveniently online at aachen.de/lara and book a bike in your neighbourhood via the evemo app. The bikes should be returned to the same station.

Car sharing

With car sharing, you don't need to buy your own car and can save many other costs such as parking, refuelling, insurance and repairs.

Simply book a car (including e-cars and vans) when you need one via movA or the Cambio app.

Car sharing in Aachen is station-based. This means that the rented car must be returned to the same station.

Premium footpaths

The nearest green space is always just a short walk away from Aachen city centre.

Ten "premium footpaths" lead you quickly and easily along special routes to the city's most beautiful parks and green spaces. Wide, easy-to-walk paths, shady trees, comfortable benches to rest on and clear signposts make each of these walks a little excursion. Ideal for a refreshing break or a relaxing nature walk, the green spaces are often only 20 minutes away from the city centre.

Not all the paths are finished yet, but the city is already making sure that walking in Aachen is safer, easier and more enjoyable. The premium footpaths invite you to discover nature and enjoy the fresh air – simply on foot! It is also possible to hike further.

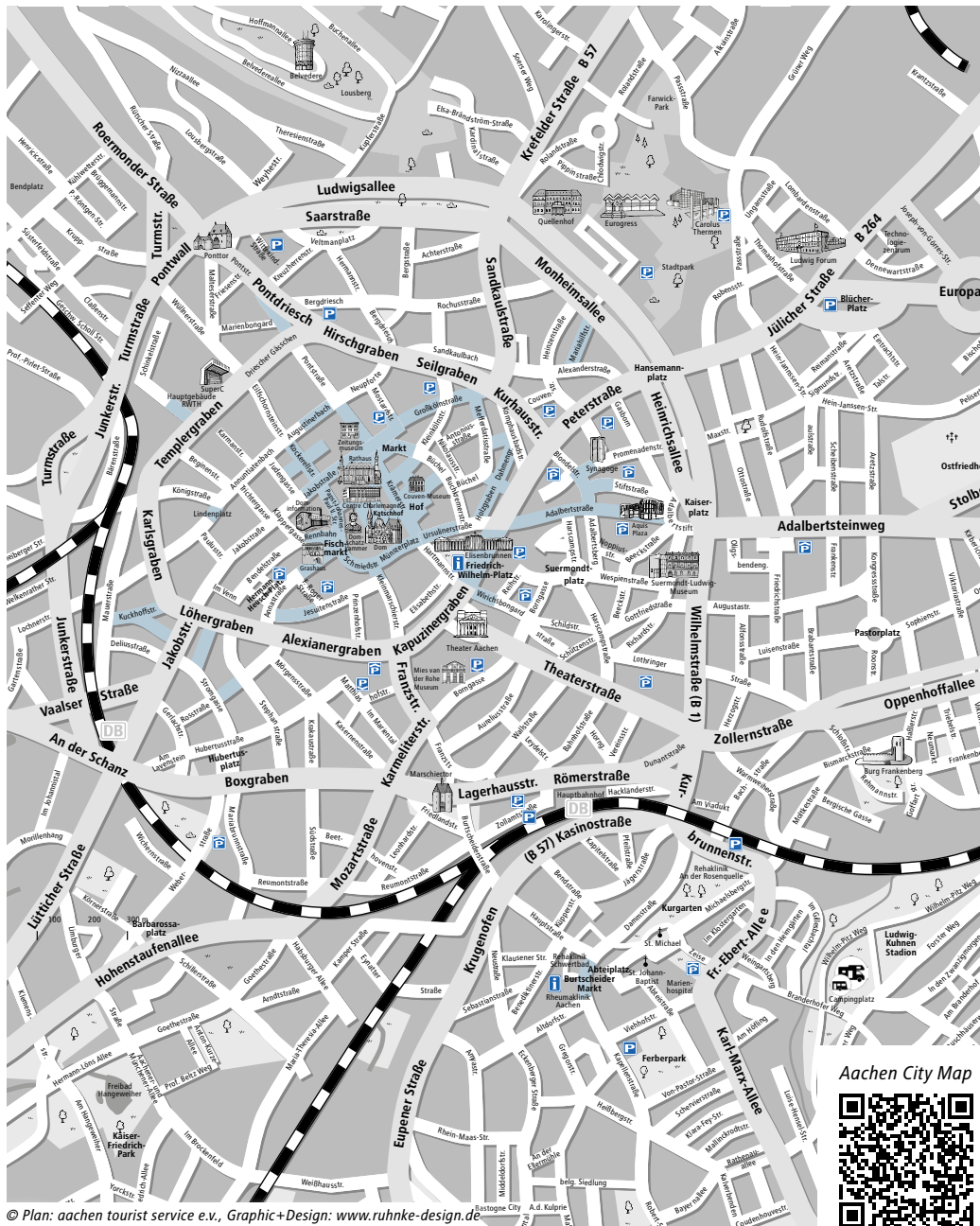

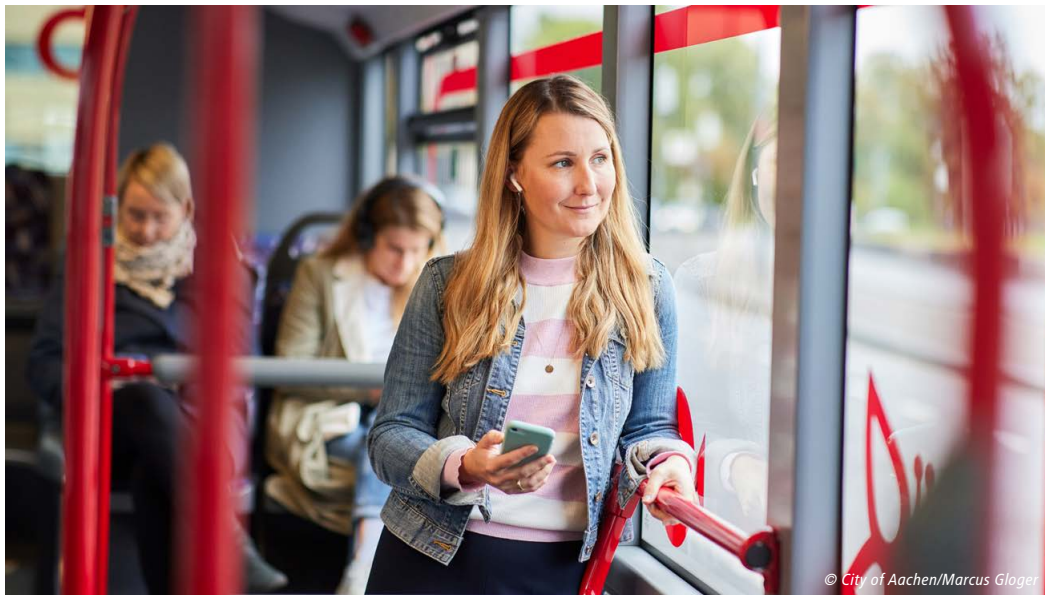

By bus and train out and about

The city of Aachen not only offers comfortable and climate-friendly public transport within the city and the surrounding areas, but also to neighbouring countries.

Buying Tickets

Tickets for local public transport can be purchased in various ways.
Bus tickets: at ticket machines at bus stops, from staff on the buses and at all ASEAG sales points (e.g. in the customer centre at Bushof);
Train tickets: at ticket machines at the central station, at Deutsche Bahn sales points (e.g. at the travel centre at the central station) and online.

Alternatively, you can also book your ticket conveniently via the movA app, which also provides you with real-time information on bus timetables and delays. Sharing offers can also be booked via the app.

Eezyticket NRW

With the NRW-wide "eezy" tariff, you can travel flexibly and cost-effectively and pay based on the air line distance.

Before travelling, please check in via movA or the naveo app and check out at your destination. The price is calculated at 1.49 euro basic price and 0.29 euro per air line kilometre, which could be significantly cheaper than a single ticket for the corresponding section. In addition, there is a monthly cost cap in the same amount as for the Deutschlandticket for journeys with the eezy tariff within NRW (11.2025).

NetLiner

The NetLiner minibus, bookable online or by phone, operates as a supplement to the fixed route buses in south and north Aachen, Haaren, south Stolberg, Simmerath, Monschau and Roetgen. The NetLiner picks you up at a stop near you and takes you to the stop of your choice.

The NetLiner can be used with regular bus tickets or subscriptions. Use the QR code to find more information about this service and the instructions for booking (the easiest way to book the NetLiner is via the movA app).

Nachtexpress (Night express)

On the nights of Friday to Saturday, Saturday to Sunday and before public holidays, ten night bus lines start from Elisenbrunnen or Bushof. The Nachtexpress lines not only serve various parts of the city, but also neighbouring towns such as Alsdorf, Herzogenrath, Kelmis, Stolberg, Würselen and Vaals as well as Roetgen and Monschau.

You can also use the ASEAG-Sammel-Auto (ASA) (ASEAG shared taxi). It runs at 00:15 and every half hour between 01:15 and 04:15, but must be ordered 45 minutes before the scheduled journey. As a special service, in the ASEAG buses you can ask the driver to order a taxi to take you the last few metres home from the bus stop. Just inform the driver in advance.

Euregieticket

The Euregieticket is a day ticket for 22.90 euro per person, valid for one day in the entire Euregio Maas-Rhein.

At weekends and on national holidays in Belgium, Germany and the Netherlands, this ticket also allows one additional adult and up to three children under the age of 12 to travel free of charge.

There is also a Euregieticket bicycle available for only 4.60 euro (11.2025).

Travelling on buses and trains with limited mobility

Accessibility

Most AVV stations are accessible (including Aachen central station and Rothe Erde). Ramps and lifts provide step-free access to the platforms, and from there it is possible to board regional trains on the same level. The trains have spacious multi-purpose compartments, passenger information systems, multiple boarding aids (e.g. wheelchair ramps) and large accessible toilets. Tactile wayfinding strips in and around railway stations make orientation easier.

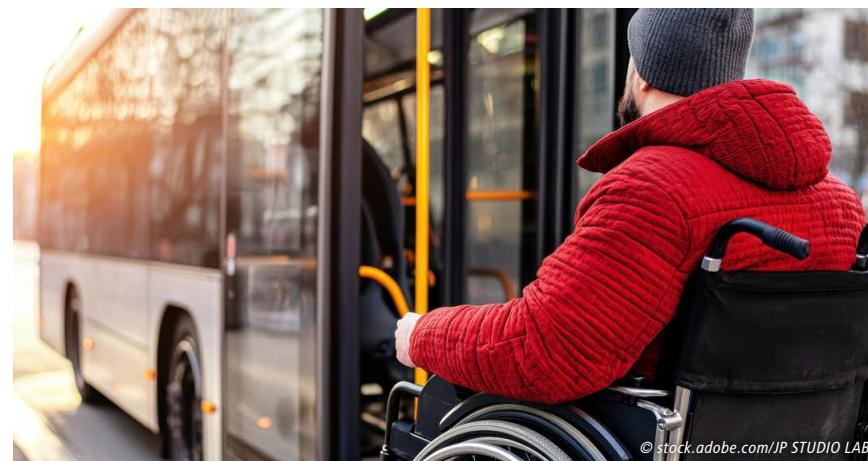
Low-cost travel

Severely disabled people with a green-orange ID card with the G, aG, Gl, Bl or H mark can obtain a supplementary sheet with a corresponding token from the relevant social services (Versorgungsamt) office, which entitles them to free local public transport. The token costs 53 euro for half a year or 104 euro for a whole year (11.2025). There are no costs for people who receive unemployment benefit or subsistence benefits or who have the H, Bl, VB or EB mark. An accompanying person can travel free of charge if a "B" is entered in the pass and the note "Authorisation to take an accompanying person is confirmed" is noted.

5. Move easily and city-friendly by car



By car in Aachen

Charging infrastructure (for public use)

Around 850 charging points for electric cars are available in the city of Aachen (06.2025). This means that around 10 vehicles (with electric battery and plug-in) share one charging point.

The charging points are located on the streets or in multi-storey car parks. E-cars with a German e-registration plate may park on the street in residents' parking zones for up to 2 hours free of charge (parking disc required).

Charging points can be found both via the City of Aachen's mobility dashboard and via various providers such as "Ladenetz.de".

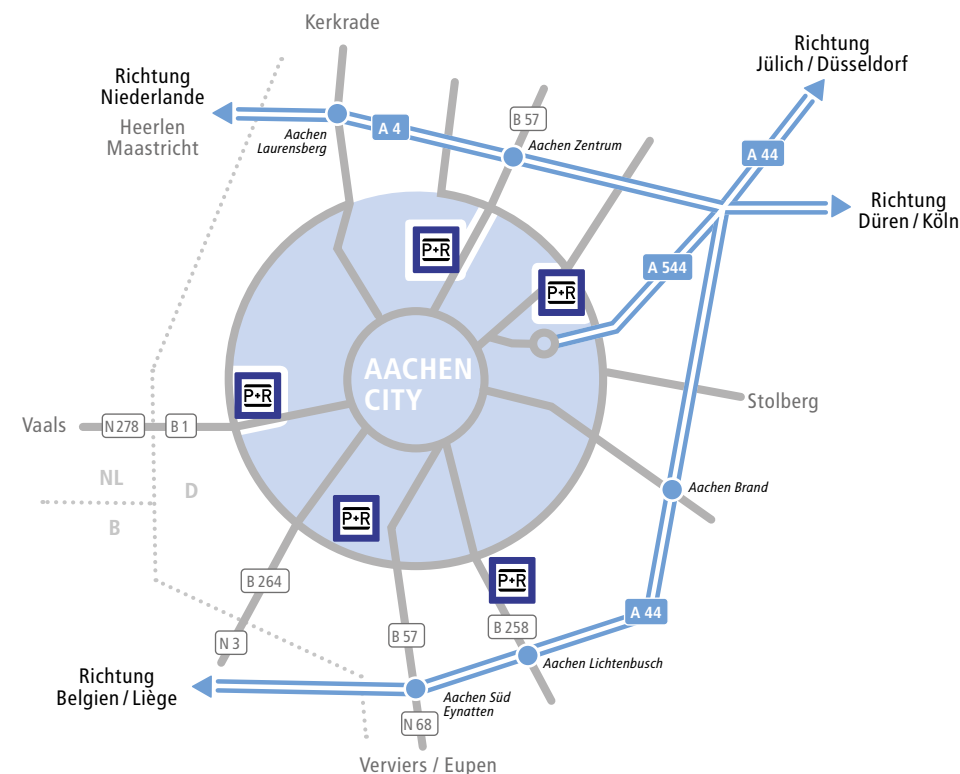
Park and Ride (P+R)

Whether for a day trip or to get to work in the city centre and avoid the traffic: You can park your car free of charge around the clock in one of the Park+Ride car parks and take the buses into the city. With just one bus ticket, which you buy from bus drivers at the Park+Ride stops for 5 euro, you and up to four other people can travel to the city centre and back (exception: in the Tivoli multi-storey car park, the parking ticket is needed and counts as a bus ticket). Locations:

- Tivoli multi-storey car park (except during Alemannia matches + CHIO)
- Jülicher Straße/Berliner Ring
- Westfriedhof
- Hangeweiher
- Waldfriedhof

These Park+Ride facilities offer a convenient way to park your car on the outskirts of the city and get to the centre quickly, easily and affordably by bus. For further information and current timetables, please visit the websites of ASEAG and the City of Aachen.

Parking in residents' parking zones

To make parking easier for residents in the city of Aachen, there are various resident parking zones. In these zones, residents with a resident parking permit pay no parking fees. Visitors are required to pay parking fees. You can purchase a resident parking permit online in the service portal of the City of Aachen or in person at the Citizens' Service Centre (Bürgerservice).

Car parks in the city centre

Space is scarce in the city centre, even for residents. That is why there are special rates for long-term parkers in many car parks. Please check the current offers of the providers (online or by telephone). APAG ("Home Parking" for 45.50 euro per month, Mon. - Thu. 16 - 9, Fridays from 14, and throughout Saturdays, Sundays and public holidays):

- Adalbertsteinweg car park
- Couvenstr. car park
- Galeria Kaufhof/City car park
- Hbf (main station) car park
- Town hall (Rathaus) car park (reopening in June 2026)
- RWTH University Hospital car park

Job parking tariffs such as 24-hour tariffs can also be found on the APAG website by selecting the car park (from the overview list) and clicking on the tariffs. Further tariffs:

- Sparkasse Aachen (car park at the cathedral, Annastrasse): 33 euro/month*
- Kapuzinerkarre car park (Borngasse), COLOGNE Parkhaus Service: Availability and price will be determined on request (e-mail: dauerhaft@parkhaus-service.de)

Contactless payment

With the easypark app, you can save yourself the trouble of searching for change at the parking ticket machines and pay for parking conveniently with your mobile phone. You can end or extend your parking time with just one click. Visitors, including residents of other residents' parking zones, must pay for parking during operating hours.

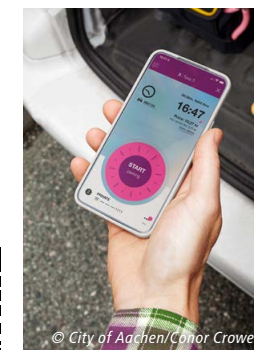
Live car park capacities

Disabled parking permit

An NRW-wide, nationwide or EU-wide parking permit for the severely disabled can be applied for by e-mail, post or in person via the road traffic authority of the City of Aachen. The main prerequisite for this is proof of a severely disabled person's pass. This can be applied for via the social services (Versorgungsamt) office at StädteRegion Aachen.

The locations of disabled parking spaces can be found in the city map for people with disabilities.

With a parking permit for the disabled, you can obtain parking concessions depending on the type of permit.
